CULTIVATING SELF-RELIANCE THROUGH ORGANIC FARMING

Navsanjeevan Social Trust, partnering with Cummins India Foundation, implemented an innovative Organic Kitchen Garden at Poona Home for Blind Girls School in Kothrud, Pune

DIVERSE CROP CULTIVATION: FROM LEAFY GREENS TO SEASONAL SPECIALTIES

The initiative encompassed a diverse range of crops including leafy vegetables, fruit-bearing, salad veggies and seasonal varieties such as marigold, watermelon, cucumber, and groundnut. This comprehensive approach provided students with complete exposure to different agricultural practices and crop cycles throughout the growing season

The varied crop selection ensured maximum utilization of available space while providing learning multiple opportunities for different farming techniques. This diverse cultivation strategy allowed students benefit from most of the produce agricultural grown on-site, enhancing both their practical skills and nutritional intake.

HANDS-ON SKILLS: PRACTICAL VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN ACTION

Students from Sau Vanu Tai Chavan High School, Tardgaon New English School Marunji & Taradgaon, Sharadatai High School-Malegaon and Sri Narsih Vidyalaya, Tathawade received hands-on exposure in four key domains: basic engineering, electrical systems, agriculture, and food processing. This multidisciplinary approach provided students with diverse technical competencies across traditional and emerging sectors, broadening their career pathway options

This innovative approach bridges the critical skill gap by introducing foundational-level practical training, ensuring students graduate with job-ready capabilities and enhanced employability prospects. PRE-VOCATIONAL SKILL EDUCATION PROGRAM

Navsanjeevan has successfully implemented the Pre-Vocational Skill Education Program for students in Grades 6, 7, and 8 in 15 schools.

HANDS-ON SKILLS: PRACTICAL VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN ACTION

Students engaged in hands-on activities such as nursery development, first aid, maker skills, cooking without fire, and science-based explorations, making learning interactive and practical.

These foundational experiences promote creativity, curiosity, and a deeper understanding of real-world concepts.

Expert teachers delivered the curriculum class-wise in small student groups, enabling personalized attention and active participation.

Assessment tools are administered in controlled environments with proper orientation, while interactive workshops encourage peer learning and collaborative exploration of career options.

Regular progress tracking ensures continuous support, and schools establish partnerships with industry professionals to provide real-world career insights. The implementation includes teacher training modules to ensure sustainable integration of career guidance principles into daily educational practices.

VOLUNTEER ENGAGEMENT: FROM CORPORATE CULTURE TO COMMUNITY CARE

Integrated Community Support Activities



2000 Nirmalya based compost

To support environmental conservation efforts, utilized 2,000 kg of nirmalya-based organic compost for kitchen garden development while maintaining chemical-free approach by avoiding the use of synthetic fertilizers and pesticides.

2 Students scholarship

Granted educational scholarships to two students and implemented awareness initiatives to promote knowledge of scholarship schemes within the academic community.



5 Internship

Offered internship opportunities to five youth and women, enabling them to observe professional work environments and engage in experiential learning.





10 Guest visits

Facilitated visits by various industry experts and development sector professionals to schools and organic kitchen garden initiatives to observe implementation processes and provide developmental guidance.

EDUCATIONAL CAPACITY ENHANCEMENT:

To expand skill-based educational initiatives by delivering integrated vocational and pre-vocational training programs to over 3,500 students across 30 institutional partnerships, thereby strengthening the foundation for youth employability and career readiness.

INTEGRATED RURAL DEVELOPMENT THROUGH SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE:

To establish a comprehensive one-acre organic demonstration facility while providing specialized training to 100+ farmers in sustainable agricultural practices and facilitating economic empowerment for 800+ women through strategic integration into agricultural value chain systems.
